Dr. Charles Sutton performs procedures using interventional radiology techniques, a minimally invasive medical specialty. CT scanning, MRI, ultrasound and fluoroscopy are used to see inside the body in fine detail without surgery.

The most common procedures, among hundreds, involve accessing an organ in order to diagnose or treat a medical problem. Biopsy or drainage can be performed without surgery. Access through a tiny hole can open the skin for hemodialysis, for kidney stone treatment or diagnosis and treatment of cancer.

Dr. Sutton's academic background includes research at Harvard Medical School to prevent pulmonary embolism and developing vascular stents at the Cleveland Clinic in Ohio. Dr. Sutton taught radiology in New York City before joining a practice in Pennsylvania, where he has worked for more than 20 years.
